✓ Does my organization engage in timely and consistent communications with our funding partners?
<ul> <li>Are we using calendars, Customer Relationship Management (CRM), and funder relations software to ensure this?</li> </ul>
✓ Beyond mere communication, how often do we connect with our funding partners?
<ul> <li>Can we improve how they see the impact of their funding?</li> </ul>
✓ What learning tools might begin to build or to enhance our culture of collaboration?
